### PRODUCTION STYLE

Families and dog lovers of all ages (recommended 3+ but infants and babies are welcome). The play is also suitable for school audiences of pre-school nursery and primary school classes.

### **WORKSHOP**

An optional drama workshop is available after the performance and for schools (KS1 KS2) with creative activities and games inspired by the world of the hunter gatherers and the wolves. The workshop is for a maximum of 25 children aged 4 and over and lasts 45 minutes.

For us, children's theatre needs to be accessible, entertaining, and above all a shared experience with audiences. When we create a new play we make sure that it will work in a village hall just as well as in a theatre, in order to reach as wide an audience as possible.
